

## **Ahavah Community Initiative Volunteer CSA Representatives\*\* Position Description**

\*\*This is a Workshare Position

Volunteers at our pickup locations are CSA Representatives. They are the face of the CSA, providing a welcoming and friendly visitor experience. Volunteers will greet shareholders, help them navigate their pick-ups, pass along important information, relay feedback to farm staff, and answer questions. They are also responsible for restocking and maintaining CSA displays, and need to be comfortable with repetitive lifting of up to 30 pounds. Farm staff will ensure proper training on both the produce and procedures of the CSA.

### **Exchange**

Volunteer CSA Representatives will commit to a specified number of hours (based on location) every single week throughout the CSA season at one of our pick up locations (Denver, Monument, or Central Colorado Springs) and in exchange will receive one CSA share during that season.

### **Scheduling**

Available shifts are:

- **Denver on Thursdays from 2 PM - 4:30 PM**  
at the Jewish Community Center, 350 S. Dahlia St., Denver, CO 80246
- **Monument on Thursdays from 11:30 AM - 1:30 PM**  
at Beasts and Brews, 7 Spectrum Loop, Colorado Springs, CO 80921
- **Central Colorado Springs on Fridays from 12:30 PM - 2:45 PM**  
at Ranch Foods Direct, 4635 Town Center Dr., Colorado Springs, CO 80916

CSA Seasons are:

- Spring (April - June)
- Summer (June - September)
- Fall (September - December)
- Winter (February - March)

### **Policies:**

- Children - ACI is committed to cultivating an educational and fulfilling space for all ages. However, children (under 16 yrs) are not permitted to come to the farm or pick up locations with volunteers during their scheduled shift. Thanks for helping us keep our work environment safe and productive.
- Pets - Pets are not permitted to come to the farm or to pickup locations with CSA volunteers during their scheduled shift. (Note: Service animals are not considered pets but must be documented).
- Attire - You'll need to be dressed appropriately for the weather with closed-toe footwear, and supply your own water bottles and other self-care items (See the Safety Brief for clothing specifics).
- Punctuality - CSA Representatives are expected to arrive and end their shifts on time.
